Strategies

> BEFORE YOU START YOUR PRESENTATION:

- Organize your thoughts
 - o Make an outline with a beginning (introduction), middle (details), and end (conclusion)
- Use images to illustrate your point
- Keep text / captions short you don't want people reading while you're talking
- Practice

> DURING YOUR PRESENTATION:

- Stick to your plan:
 - Limit digressions or distractions
- Make eye contact with members of the audience;
- Speak clearly, and a bit slower than you might ordinarily:
 - o The room is large, so you may have to speak a bit more loudly than usual.
- Be comfortable, but try to stand still
 - Don't fidget
- If you use slides or handouts, don't read from them
 - There should be as little text associated with them as possible, so you shouldn't have to read anything.
