

USING ARCHIVE.ORG

In the upper right corner of the ARCHIVE.ORG homepage, click "Sign Up."



When prompted, input your email address, and create and input a USER ID and PASSWORD.


After you have created your own account, you can use the "Advanced Search" option (blue text immediately under the "GO" button, mid-screen) to find the texts.



This will take you to the main search data input page. Once there, I recommend that you input the "Creator" (author) and the "Title."



You will then be given images of any of the materials found that fit the prompts.



Moving your screen's cursor over the material will reveal the status of that specific source: free to download, free to borrow (for various periods of time), or available for purchase (through a separate vendor). Click on the item you wish to borrow.

You can select your viewing options by clicking on the small down-arrow in the blue field toward the top of the screen.



PLEASE NOTE: You will be unable to "preview" more than a few pages until you select your viewing option. However, once you have done so, you will be taken to an almost identical screen; however, the blue borrowing options button has been replaced by a red "Return Now" button. You will now be able to view all of the pages in the work.
